## Transcripts Seem Lighter On Delivery Than on TV

WASHINGTON — The transcripts of
President Nixon's Watergate conversations turned out to be far less overwhelming in physical size than it appeared to television viewers Monday

night.

Those impressive stacks of binders that flanked Mr. Nixon as he announced he was releasing the transcripts apparently included more than one set of the

ently included more than one set of the material. Stripped of the fancy covers that the House Judiciary Committee got, the 1,308 pages measure only 2½ inches thick.

What was passed out to reporters yesterday afternoon was an eight-by-10-inch book, resembling a hig-city phone directory. The pages are typewritten and double-spaced.
