According to transcripts of

taped conversations taped conversations re-leased by the White House, the remarks were made on April 27, 1973, in Mr. Nixon's Oval Office, with Deputy At-torney General Henry Peter-son, and White House press resen and White House press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler present.

Agnew had not yet been implicated publicly in the Maryland graft investigation "He'd love it," Mr. Nixon "that led to his own resignation 51/2 months later.
