The House Judiciary Committee said yesterday telegrams it is getting are running heavily against President Nixon's decision to give it edited transcripts instead of the tapes it subpoenaed.

The latest tabulation by

the staff lists 10,051 telegrams urging the committee to insist on getting the tapes and 784 supporting Mr. Nixon's position.

A staff aide said 2508 more telegrams that arrived yesterday have not been tabulated.
