## TRANSCRIPT REPORTS SATISFY NIXON AIDES

WASHINGTON, May 3 (UPI) —White House officials ap-peared generally satisfied today with the newspaper reporting of the Watergate transcripts and said the accounts were "begin-ming to report and say that the President was not involved" in the cover-up. A high White House official

A high White House official said that immediately after the transcripts were released Tues-day there was, as expected, "a focusing on the most contro-versial sections of the tapes and details of the dramatic dis-closures." "These early reports, again as was expected, do not fully place into focus the full Water-gate story as told by the 1,300-page book and that was ex-pected," he said. "But we do find that as the days pass re-porters have a chance to read the full volume, they are fo-cusing on the substance and they are finding and beginning to report and say that the President was not involved."
