Macmillan Inc. will publish the transcripts in a three-volume "Brentano edition" for \$10.95. The soft-cover volumes will have pages \$1/2 by 11 inches, the same size as the 1-volume \$12.50 edition published by the Government Printing Office in Washington this week.

All three publishers will include the White House summary and the legal argument by James D. Sinclair, the President's lawyer, which accompanied the transcripts when they were given to the House Judiciary Committee.

Additional material prepared by editors and writers of The New York Times and its book division, Quadrangle, will be included in the Bantam edition,
