

New Rebozo Probe By IRS Reported

The Internal Revenue Service has begun a new examination of the bank records of President Nixon's friend Charles G. Rebozo the Miami Herald said yesterday.

The IRS refused comment on the reported investigation.

Last October 31, Rebozo said the IRS had investigated his Key Biscayne bank and his participation in a \$100,000 Nixon re-election campaign contribution from billionaire Howard Hughes.

Rebozo said the probe had cleared him of wrongdoing.

Rebozo has confirmed receiving the \$100,000, but has said that he returned the money after leaving it untouched in a bank vault for three years.

Herbert Kalmbach, Mr. Nixon's former personal attorney reportedly has testified that Rebozo told him portions of the money were given or loaned to the President's brother, Donald Nixon, and Mr. Nixon's secretary, Rose Mary Woods.
