

Tax Curb on Tapes Sought

WASHINGTON, May 10 (AP) — A bill that would ban President Nixon from receiving a tax deduction for charitable contributions of the White House tape recordings has been introduced by Representative Jonathan Bingham, Bronx Democrat. In a statement yesterday, Mr. Bingham cited news reports — unconfirmed by the White House — that said the purpose of making the tapes was that they would be a future donation for tax purposes.
