

A Potomac Dinner Cruise

Washington

President Nixon invited nine key House members to dinner on the presidential yacht Sequoia last night.

Deputy press secretary Gerald L. Warren, in announcing the dinner cruise on the Potomac river, said

Mr. Nixon "wanted to have an informal get-together with some of his friends in the House of Representatives."

Republicans joining in the cruise were House GOP whip Leslie Arends of Illinois and Representatives Samuel Devine of Ohio, El-

ford Cederberg of Michigan, Glenn Davis of Wisconsin and Robert Michel of Illinois.

Three of the four Democrats joining the group are committee chairman — F. Edward Hebert of Louisiana, armed services; Olin Teague of Texas, science

and astronautics; and Richard Ichord of Missouri, internal security. The fourth Democrat was Representative Joe D. Waggoner of Louisiana, who has led several delegations of supporters to White House audiences with Mr. Nixon.
