

# Reagan Talks Of the Transcripts

Sacramento

Governor Ronald Reagan said yesterday that the White House transcripts show President Nixon did not know of the Watergate break-in or the ensuing cover-up.

Reagan added that he joins the Democratic leadership of Congress in recommending against a presidential resignation.

"I think many have agreed that the President did not have knowledge of the break-in or of the cover-up," Reagan told his weekly

news conference in the state Capitol.

"The statements in those earlier meetings made it plain that this was true."

He added his voice to those calling for the impeachment process to continue as the proper legal channel to investigate charges against the President.

"I don't think resignation would solve anything," Reagan said. "The constitutional process is going forward. I think that is what should happen."
