

# Sammy Davis' Regrets

St. Louis, Mo.

Sammy Davis Jr. said yesterday he is disappointed in the Nixon administration and had made a mistake in his all-out support of President Nixon during the 1972 election.

Davis said he was not talking about "the man," but about the administration.

Davis said if Mr. Nixon is guilty the country should get him out of office, but there

should not be character assassination.

"I'm terribly disappointed — disappointed nothing more has been done for the disenfranchised people, the third world people," Davis said.

He said the administration had promised something would be done for the poor whites and needy blacks, but that nothing was done.

Davis was one of the most prominent blacks to support

the President in 1972. He made a widely publicized appearance with Mr. Nixon at a campaign rally during the Republican National Convention in Miami Beach.
