

An Early Release

Herbert L. Porter, former scheduling director of the Committee to Re-elect the President, was released from the federal correctional institution here three days early for good behavior, it was learned yesterday.

The warden's office said Porter, who pleaded guilty of lying to the FBI about the

disposition of funds of the committee, was released last Friday, after serving 27 days of a scheduled 30-day sentence. (17 MAY)

Porter had told the FBI the disputed money went to conservative students. He later told the Senate Watergate committee he had given the money to G. Gordon Liddy, convicted overseer of the Watergate break-in.
