

Presidential aide released

Herbert Porter, former presidential aide, has been released from the Federal Correctional Institution in Lompoc after serving 27 days of a 30-day sentence.

The former scheduling director of the Committee to Re-elect the President was released Friday with his term reduced by three days for good behavior, a spokesman said. The one year's probation included in his sentence remains in effect, the spokesman said.

Porter had pleaded guilty to lying to FBI agents about where the committee's money went.
