Porter Given

## Early Release

LOMPOC, Calif., May 20 (UPI)—Herbert L. Porter, former scheduling director of the Committee for the Re-election of the President, was released from the federal correctional institution three days early for good behavior, it was learned today.

The warden's office said Porter, who pleaded guilty to lying to the FBI about the disposition of funds of the committee, was released May 17 after serving 27 days of a 30-day sentence.

Porter entered the prison April 22 after voluntarily arriving at the prison gates early to avoid newsmen.

His sentence includes one year of probation after the short period of incarceration.
