Nixon's Gallup Rating 25% in Latest Survey

The Gallup Poll has found that President Nixon's latest popularity rating, taken May 10 to 13, was 25 per cent and matched his low point to date, recorded in a survey taken in early April.

Developments of recent weeks, including Mr. Nixon's release of the transcripts of the White House tapes, have had virtually no effect on his popularity rating, the survey

The President's rating, since January has fluctuated by only 1 or 2 percentage points in 10 measurements taken over that time, the poll found. Mr. Nixon's high point of popularity since the start of the year, 28 per cent, was recorded in a survey taken Feb. 1-4.
