Nixon in Key Biscayne
For Holiday Weekend

KEY BISCAAYNE, Fla., May 24 (UPI)—President Nixon flew here today for a long Memorial Day weekend, accompanied by a small contingent of staffers and no members of his family.

The President was welcomed at Homestead Air Force Base by Col. Ted Guy, vice wing commander at the base, who was a prisoner of war in North Vietnam for five years.

Mr. Nixon planned to announce the appointment of Kenneth Rush, Deputy Secretary of State, as the new White House economic coordinator in a nationwide radio address at noon tomorrow. At the same time, the President is expected to discuss Administration policy in coping with inflation.

Ronald L. Ziegler, the White House press secretary, said Mr. Nixon planned to make another radio address on Monday, Memorial Day.
