'Hardcore 38% for Nixon'

NEW YORK—Time magazine reported yesterday that a "hard-core" of 38 percent of Americans want President Nixon to stay in office.

The magazine said in its issue that will appear this week that this compared with 60 percent last August.

The sizable minority who want him to stay, Time said, "is solidifying into a loyalists bastion that is supporting him with growing determination."

"Americans are becoming increasingly polarized," the magazine went on, "with 53 percent wanting Nixon out of office and 38 percent wanting him to stay."
