Discontinued by Nixon

KEY BISCAVNE, Fla., May 26 (UPI)—President Nixon stopped the logging of visitors to the White House family quarters and the comings and goings of his family a few months ago, a spokesman said Sunday.

Tom Decair, an assistant White House press secretary, confirmed a report by a Washington Post columnist that the traditional usher's logbook, a record that has been kept for 90 years in the White House, had been discontinued.
