\$90,000 In Gifts for Nixon Taxes

Public donations designed to help President Nixon pay his delinquent federal income taxes now total \$90,000, the White House announced yesterday.

The money, except anonymous donations, is being returned to the senders since Mr. Nixon has announced he will pay the taxes himself.

The anonymous funds, which the White House said come to \$4341 were turned over at Mr. Nixon's request to the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration to aid victims of recent Midwest tornadoes.

Most contributions sent to the President were in gifts. ranging from \$1 to \$10.
