Nixon Aide Says It's All the Media's Fault

A Nixon administration official said yesterday the most powerful news organizations in the country had created a climate around President Nixon that has been largely responsible for the moves to impeach him.

"Any administration could have been brought to this point and beyond if the most powerful news organizations had created the medieval climate that they have created in this case," said Bruce Herschensohn, deputy special assistant to the Pres-

ident.

This climate, he said, "is in a great part responsible for the impeachment movements."

Herschensohn made the remarks in an interview before speaking to a luncheon of the National Committee to Support the Presidency.

He cited as examples stories from the New York Times News Service, the Akron Beacon Journal, United Press International and the Washington Post, and reports by the networks.
