House Vote On Nixon-A Prediction

The House majority leader predicted yesterday that the House will impeach President Nixon if the Judiciary Committee recommends it.

"In my opinion, if the Judiciary Committee votes to impeach the President of the United States, I believe that he'll be impeached by a minimum of 80 votes and higher," said Representative Thomas P. O'Neill, (Dem-Mass.)
