## 'Impeachment Ball' to Be Held in S.F.

An "Impeachment Ball" sponsored by a group of self-described "nobodies" will be held June 22 at the Sheraton Palace Hotel from 9 p.m. to 2 a.m.

The ball is an attempt to parody, down to the detail of engraved invitations, the Inaugural Ball of President Nixon.

"We're just a group of basic nobodies who thought it would be neat to have a party, and to show that there's a lot of people out here who think the Constitution takes priority over Richard Nixon," said Robert Caughlan of Palo Alto, one of the sponsors.

Organizers, he said, are mostly Peninsula junior executives who helped form the Sam Ervin Fan Club last summer. More than 200 of the \$10 tickets have been sold.
