**Mrs. Kissinger Enters
 Hospital for 10 Days**

WASHINGTON, June 13—The State Department said today that Mrs. Henry A. Kissinger, the wife of the Secretary of State, had entered Bethesda Naval Hospital today for 10 days to two weeks of examination and treatment in connection with a history of ulcer trouble.

A spokesman would not go into detail on Mrs. Kissinger's condition, but he said that she went to the hospital outside of Washington in suburban Maryland by car and not ambulance.

Mrs. Kissinger, the former Nancy Maginnes, a foreign affairs specialist, was married to Mr. Kissinger on March 3.

Mrs. Kissinger's stay in the hospital may interfere with plans for a dinner dance in honor of the Kisingers' marriage being given on June 22 at the Rockefeller estate in Pocantico Hills, N.Y.
