Buzhardt, to rest Nixon's Counsel, For Two Months

The White House confirmed yesterday that J. Fred Buzhardt, counsel to the President, had suffered a heart attack.

Hospital sources said the No. 2 man on President Nixon's Watergate defense team probably will be recuperating for two months.

Buzhardt has been widely regarded as the leading legal expert on the critical White House tapes of Mr. Nixon's conversations and he was in charge of transcription of those which were made public six weeks ago.
