Now Want Nixon Removed

The latest Harris survey, conducted nationwide among a cross-section of 1,413 adults, showed for the first time that a majority of the American people favored the impeachment of President Nixon and his removal from office.

United Press International reported yesterday that the survey found that by 61 to 28 per cent, the public believed the House Judiciary Committee should vote to bring impeachment charges against the President, and by 52 to 35 per cent of those who were questioned felt that he should be impeached and removed from office.
