A variety of placards were held up along President Nixon's motorcade route to Jerusalem today. Some praised him, some criticized him, others referred to Watergate. One of them said, "Welcome, President Ford."

Here's what some of the other placards said: "Blessed be your welcome, Mr. Nixon." Another one, "Don't sell us out." "Palestine is the land of Israel." "Welcome to my President." "Good old Nixon." "Remove all the expletives." "You cannot run from justice."

And another one being held up for the President to see as he drove into Jerusalem was a sign that said, "We are all Jew-boys."
