But I guess he's a lot more sensitive than people think." said Mans-field. "He's a little thin-skinned and not really used to the hazards of politics, or at least not as much as he is used to the laurels." Mansfield, a member of the Senate Foreign Rela-tions Committee, said he ad-vised Kissinger not to quit; that his energies and capa-bilities are needed. that his energies and capa-bilities are needed.
