## U.S.-Arab Links

Damascus

Five of the six Arab nations that broke diplomatic relations with the United States during the 1967 Middle East war have now restored them.

Syria and the United

States agreed to renew ties at the end of President Nixon's visit to Damascus yesterday.

Other countries that have resumed relations are Egypt, Sudan, Algeria and North Yemen. Iraq has not.
