**Accountant Says Nixon
Has Filed 1973 Taxes**

WASHINGTON, June 15 (AP) — As the 60-day extension for President Nixon to file his 1973 Federal income tax return expired Saturday, his accountant said the return had been filed within the last several weeks.

Earlier in the day, the White House declined to say whether the return had been filed or another extension sought.

But Mr. Nixon's accountant in Los Angeles, Arthur Blech, said by telephone that he "had prepared the President's returns and they have been filed within the last several weeks."

Mr. Blech said he did not know why the White House would not say that the returns had been filed.
