WXPost Jun 1 9 1974 Brooke Renews Call for Nixon To Resign Office

WICHITA, Kans., June 18 (UPI)—Sen. Edward Brooke (R-Mass.) renewed his call Monday for President Nixon to resign for the good of the country and politicians of both parties.

"Nothing has occurred to make me change my mind since last November," said Brooke, who last year became the first Republican senator to publicly as the President to step down.

Brooke spoke at an informal airport news conference before a speech at Wichita State University.
