## Teamsters top donor to 'fairness'

WASHINGTON — The largest single contribution to the National Citizens Committee for Fairness to the Presidency has come from the Teamsters Union, committee president Rabbi Baruch Konff said yesterday.

Korff said the Teamsters had donated \$25,000 to the operations of the group which opposes impeachment of President Nixon.

A Teamsters spokesman said he knew nothing of the contribution and the union's president, Frank Fitzsimmons, could not be reached for comment.

Korff said he explained the committee to Fitzsimmons and pointed out that activities of the committee are educational and not political, because President Nixon cannot run for reelection.

Most contributions for the organization are small ones from individuals, Korff said, with amounts only occasionally rising as high as \$100.
