

'Worst yet' to come' on Nixon

HARTFORD, Conn.—Rep. John Conyers Jr., a Democratic member of the House Judiciary Committee, says the panel has heard evidence of "numerous impeachable offenses" by President Nixon which have not been made public.

The Michigan Democrat was interviewed on the WPOP radio program, "Newsbeat." The program will be aired today.

"The overwhelming amount of confidential material that is damaging to the President or could be construed as not favorable to the President has not ever been revealed," Conyers said.

Conyers said "the worst is yet to come" in the committee's impeachment inquiry. He did not elaborate.
