Colson Disbarred In D.C.

Charles W. Colson, the former White House aide who pleaded guilty of obstructing justice in trying to smear Daniel Ellsberg, was disbarred yesterday by the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia. forwarded to other juris-

Such notices routinely are dictions where a lawyer is admitted to the bar and usually result in total disbarment. Colson had been licensed to practice also in Virginia and Massachusetts.

The judges noted that Colson stood convicted of a felony and said "he hereby is disbarred from further practice of law before the bar of this court."
