

**Priest Calls on Rodino  
To Disqualify Himself**

BOSTON, July 2 (AP) — The Rev. Dr. John J. McLaughlin, a Jesuit White House aide, today called the House Judiciary Committee's chairman, Peter W. Rodino Jr., "a crude political tactician" and said that he should disqualify himself from the impeachment deliberations.

He said that Mr. Rodino had countenanced leaks of committee deliberations to the news media and "rubber-hosed" Democrats into changing their votes on whether to hear Administration witnesses privately.

Father McLaughlin said that published reports, if true, that Mr. Rodino had said all committee Democrats would vote for impeachment were "an appalling admission of anti-Nixon bias."

Mr. Rodino has denied the reports.
