Nixon's Notes

This photo shows a copy of the third of four pages of notes made by President Nixon on April 15, 1973, the Sunday that former Attorney General Richard Kleindienst and Assistant Attorney General Henry E. Petersen told Mr. Nixon the massive coverup story outlined to

them by federal prosecutors.

There were several meetings April 15; the White House says it was one of the days that tape reels recording Mr. Nixon's conversations ran out and the talks went unrecorded.

The page of notes was among the reports released yesterday by the House Judiciary Committee in its impeachment investigation.

Eight large volumes of material assembled by the committee thus far was released.
