On Budget at San Clemente

San Clemente

President Nixon relaxed at the beach and poolside with members of his family yesterday on the first weekend of a two week stay at the Western White House. During a rainy Sunday morning, aides said the President conferred with chief of staff Alexander M. Haig Jr. and press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler. There was no report on what was discussed. Spokesmen for the President emphasized that Mr. Nixon intends to concentrate on economic problems while he is here, and said he will be working on economic and budget matters today.
