Nixon Evidence
Overwhelming,
Alioto Believes

The evidence is "over-whelming" that President Nixon obstructed justice and used government agencies to persecute his political enemies, Mayor Joseph L. Alioto said yesterday.

However, the mayor then added that he is "not sure" the House of Representatives will vote a bill of impeachment and is "rather sure" the Senate will not vote to impeach the president.

The mayor's remarks were similar to those of Democratic National Chairman Robert' S. Strauss, who said Tuesday the evidence against President Nixon was "devastating."
