

Action Against Kleindienst

Is Studied by Arizona Bar

PHOENIX, Ariz., July 17

(Reuters) — The Arizona State Bar Association said today that its administrative committee was studying possible disciplinary action against former Attorney General Richard G. Kleindienst.

Mr. Kleindienst pleaded guilty in United States District Court in Washington in May to failing to reply fully to a question in 1972 Senate Judiciary Committee hearings.

A perjury charge against him was dropped as part of a plea bargaining procedure and he received a suspended 30-day jail term and a suspended \$100 fine.

In disclosing that Mr. Kleindienst's accreditation was being discussed, the bar association said that no further statements would be issued on the case until a decision was reached.
