

Gurney Pleads Not Guilty

And Is Released on Bond

JACKSONVILLE, Fla., July 16

(UPI)—Senator Edward J. Gurney, Republican of Florida, was arraigned Tuesday on charges of bribery, perjury and conspiracy in a surprise appearance before United States Magistrate Joseph Hatchett.

Florida's senior Senator and member of the Senate Watergate Committee pleaded not guilty to all the charges and was freed on a personal recognizance bond.

Senator Gurney and six others were indicted by a Federal grand jury last Wednesday in the alleged collection of money from Florida builders in return for promises of favored treatment by the Federal Housing
