Moore, asked yesterday who "W" was, identified him 'as former White House chief of staff H. R. (Bob) Haldeman, the man who in more than four years built a reputation for insulating President Nixon from outsiders and

for insulating President Nixon from outsiders and cold-shouldering even Cabinet members. "W" stood for Halde-man's Signal Corps code name, Moore said, which was: "Welcome."
