Massachusetts Court Bars Colson as Lawyer

However, Justice Benja-min Kaplan said that Mr. Colson could appeal the sus-pension. Mr. Colson is serving a 1-to-3-year sentence in Federal prison after pleading guilty to a charge of obstructing justice in the case of the break-in at the office of Dan-iel Ellsberg's former psychia-trist.
