Convicted Watergate conspirator E. Howard Hunt says he's retiring to Miami to find privacy among his Cuban-American friends.

The former CIA agent, coordinator of the Cuban invasion at the Bay of Pigs, was convicted of helping plan the burglary and bugging of Democratic National Headquarters in June, 1972. He was sentenced to 2½-to-8 years in prison and served ten months before being released pending appeal.

Hunt, 56, bought an elegant \$80,000, four-bedroom home with a swimming pool in the northeast section of Miami.
