## **Ehrlichman Files for New Trial**

Washington

John D. Ehrlichman yesterday filed a motion for a new trial in the Ellsberg break - in case on the ground that the presiding judge made "facial expressions and other gestures" that reflected unfavorably on Ehrlichman's credibility.

Lawyers for Ehrlichman, former President Nixon's domestic adviser, also claimed U.S. District Judge Gerhard A. Gesell improperly instructed the jury which in part led to his conviction on conspiracy and lying charges. Ehrlichman faces sentencing at the end of the month.
