

## Attorney for Gurney Asks For Dismissal

Jacksonville, Fla.

An attorney for Senator Edward J. Gurney, (Rep - Fla.) asked yesterday that bribery, perjury and conspiracy indictments against the senator be dismissed on the ground that the grand jury which returned them was illegally empaneled.

Motions by C. Harris Dittmar said Gurney and six others were indicted by a special grand jury that was not drawn and sworn under a certificate signed by the attorney general, a deputy attorney general or a designated assistant attorney general, as required by federal law. Instead, Dittmar contended, the special grand jury "was drawn and sworn in as a result of an assistant U.S. attorney."
