Paul F. Hellmuth, managing partner of the Boston law firm of Hale & Door, was listed officially as president of Anderson Security Consultants, Inc.

The company, based in Springfield, Va., until it disbanded last year, reportedly specialized in debugging offices and shredding sensitive documents for defense contractors.

Charles W. Colson, former White House special counsel, said in a tape-recorded talk with a private investigator that Anderson Security was owned by the C.I.A.

Two other lawyers who had been associated with Anderson Security said in interviews yesterday they were convinced that the company was being utilized by the intelligence agency. They asked not to be identified.

John D. Marks, co-author of "The C.I.A. and the Cult of Intelligence," said that Anderson Security, "is a C.I.A. front company. There is no pretense of private ownership here. The C.I.A. owns it and runs it," he said.

A spokesman for Hale & Dear agency of the Mr. Hellmuth

A spokesman for Hale & Door said that Mr. Hellmuth was still a partner in the law firm. Mr. St. Clair withdrew in late December when he became President Nixon's lawyer.
