**HIGH COURT REFUSES
TO TAKE SIRICA CASE**

WASHINGTON, July 25 (UPI) — The Supreme Court turned down today a bid by former Attorney General John N. Mitchell and a Watergate codefendant to disqualify United States District Judge John J. Sirica from presiding at the Watergate cover-up trial in September.

Mr. Mitchell and Kenneth W. Parkinson, attorney for the Committee for the Re-election of the President, contended that the Judge had shown bias in favor of the prosecution and that "the conduct of the trial judge himself is the subject of relevant evidence which will be before the jury."
