## 'War Crimes' Protest at The Debate

## Washington

A young man interrupted the House Judiciary Committee's impeachment inquiry yesterday by shouting, "Mr. Chairman, why isn't the President being impeached for war crimes—aren't war crimes as important as tapes?"

Committee Chairman Peter W. Rodino (Dem-N.J.) looked stunned and a moment later pounded his gavel saying: "Silence or you will have to leave the room."

A plainclothes detective moved toward the young man who had entered the room as part of a rotating group of the public.

A young woman also was escorted from the room.

Outside, they identified themselves as Sal Scafiei and Nancy Dorst and said they were from Baltimore and "of the Baltimore-Washington Nonviolence Community."
