Here is the 28 to 10 roll call vote by which the House Judiciary Committee voted last night to recommend a second article of impeachment which accuses President Nixon of abusing the powers of the presidency.

In an identical, earlier vote, the committee approved language changes proposed by Representative William L. Hungate (Dem-Mo.) for a version of Article 2 introduced by Representative Harold P. Donohue (Dem-Mass.).
