

**Reinecke Won't Quit Post
Unless Required by Law**

WASHINGTON, July 29(UPI) —Lieut. Gov. Ed Reinecke of California, convicted last Saturday on Federal perjury charges, said today that he would not resign unless legally required to do so.

Mr. Reinecke talked with reporters after a two-hour meeting with James R. Pace, chief probation officer for the United States District Court, in preparation for a pre-sentencing report.

Mr. Reinecke also said he would not take a leave of absence while his case was being appealed if state law did not require him to step down. The appeal is expected to take up to a year. Mr. Reinecke said his office in Sacramento was studying the matter.
