
Demo Calls For Removal Of Reinecke

William Norris, the Democratic nominee for attorney general, said here yesterday "the law is clear cut" that Lieutenant Governor Ed Reinecke should be removed from office.

Norris faulted his Republican opponent, incumbent Attorney General Evelle Younger, for not having prepared an opinion on the case prepared in advance of the outcome of Reinecke's trial.

"I've studied the state Constitution and the government code," Norris said, and it is very clear the Constitution calls for a removal from public trust anyone convicted of perjury.

"It's unthinkable an official could be convicted of such a felony and remain in office during years of appeal, particularly with the enormous power the lieutenant governor has when he is acting governor."
