

To Wallace

Birmingham, Ala.

President Nixon asked Alabama Democrats Governor George C. Wallace and Senator James Allen to urge Representative Walter Flowers to vote against impeachment in the House Judiciary Committee, the Birmingham Post - Herald said yesterday.

In a story by the newspaper's Washington correspondent, the Post - Herald quotes "a source close to the White House" as saying Mr. Nixon made the request last week in an apparent last ditch effort to sway the impeachment vote in the committee.

Flowers, a Democrat from Tuscaloosa, voted for two of the three proposed articles of impeachment adopted by the committee.

Allen declined to confirm if he was called by anyone at the White House and Wallace would not confirm the report, the Post-Herald said.

The paper said Flowers was surprised when asked about the report and said neither Allen nor Wallace had contacted him.
